Dear Parents and Carers,

It's all starting to feel festive now! Following the superb PTA Christmas Fayre last week, we are now looking forward to welcoming Bussage pupils, families and others from the locality to our annual Community Carols event on Monday 5th December at 6pm. Feel free to bring your neighbours or wider family along to the school hall for some carolling and perhaps a mince pie!

Spring Term school lunch menu choices:

Your child should have brought home their menu choice form for Spring Term this week. The kitchen and office are requesting that all menus are returned to school by **Monday 12th December** please so that food orders may be placed.

Pantomime:

On Friday 6th January, when the majority of the school are visiting the pantomime, regular school lunch choices will be suspended for the day and only a packed lunch option will be available (cheese, tuna, ham or egg). A lunch choice form for that specific day will be sent home separately over the next few days so that you may select if your chid will require a school packed lunch making for them or if you will provide your child with a packed lunch instead. Please ensure that the £7.50 ticket contribution for your child's visit to the Pantomime is paid by the end of next week (9.12.22). If you are a parent helper for this event and have yet to pay for your ticket, please may you do so, thank you. Again, a huge thank you to our PTA who are paying for the coaches and who have subsidised each pupil ticket.

Health and Safety:

It has been noticed that more and more children are attending school wearing a range of jewellery. We politely request that only a watch and/or stud earrings are permitted to be worn. Bracelets (friendship bands or otherwise) and rings should NOT be worn as they may cause a health and safety risk during our school activities. Any child wearing rings, bracelets or dangly earrings will be asked to remove them and place them safely into their bags.

KS2 Christmas Carol Services and KS1 Nativities

We look forward to welcoming you into school to watch these performances/services. Your tickets should have come home to you this week. Any spare tickets are allocated on a first come first served basis from 8:30 on Monday morning. On KS1 performance day (8.12.22) your child will need to be back in school at 5pm ready for a 5:30pm start. On KS2 Carol Service days (13.12.22 & 14.12.22) Your child should arrive back in school between 5:30 and 5:40 pm ready for a 6pm start. KS2 children should wear their usual school uniform for the services but are permitted to wear tinsel in their hair or a Christmas hat if they should wish, however please be advised that it gets very hot in the hall.

We very much expect that all KS2 children attend both of the evening services, however If your child is unable to attend either of the KS2 Carol Services, please ensure that their class teacher is told in advance. As you can imagine, a lot of time and effort goes into putting together performances and services for parents, therefore it can be rather disappointing for both staff and the other pupils when children don't turn up!















School Business Manager:

We are delighted to announce that we have appointed a new part-time School Business Manager. Some of you may remember Mrs Jane Smith who worked at Bussage in the office some years ago. We are all very excited to see her return to Bussage C of E Primary. She will be starting with us in January and will continue to be supported brilliantly in the school office by Mrs Rigg.
