Parent Consultation Evenings:

Music performances:

Year 3 and 4 wowed their audience this week during their Recorder and Clarinet concert. All of the children showed true musicianship by playing a varied repertoire of pieces that they had learned so brilliantly over the past ten weeks in their instrumental sessions. The concert ended with a wonderful premier of a joint recorder and clarinet piece, 'Happy or sad' where all of the 54 musicians played beautifully together. Year 3 & 4 Iron Age visit:

As part of their theme, 'Stone Age Rocks!' both Class 3 and 4 have attended Iron Age experience days over the last week in order to understand better what life was like during the Iron Age. They enjoyed getting really mucky creating wattle and daub, cooked damper bread on the fire inside the round house and explored the area of the Iron age settlement to find out what would have been useful to people living there during the time period. The people from the Wildlife Trust who ran the sessions commented on how wonderfully behaved and how curious our children were. They were great ambassadors for our school.

Year 1 & 2 Sudeley Castle visit:

As part of their theme, 'Once upon a time', Year 1 and 2 had a magical day out at Sudeley Castle. The children loved exploring the castle and its grounds. They found it fascinating learning all about Henry VIII and his last wife, Catherine Parr who is buried there. Again, our children behaved beautifully and were a credit to our school.
