Wellbeing: This year we have the fortune of being invited to take part in the Trailblazers project, which is provided by a partnership of health services in Gloucestershire in order to promote and support good mental health in our young people. I'm sure you will agree with us in the fact that the previous few years navigating a pandemic have taken a toll on all people, adults and children alike, therefore it is essential that we continue to talk about thoughts and feelings with our young people both in and out of school.


