 English TEXT - Funnybones, by Janet & Allan Ahlberg Reading, exploring and writing stories with familiar settings (set in places such as a park, supermarket, home, school). Reading, exploring and writing reports, including newspaper reports. Writing instructions and a character description. GRAMMAR - learning about time connectives, nouns, expanded noun phrases, verbs, imperative verbs, command sentences, coordinating conjunctions. READING COMPREHENSION - Fiction and non-fiction texts including stories, poems, instructions and information texts. Focusing on strategies to find the answers to questions: skimming and scanning, detailed focused reading.  <u>Maths</u> Practising and consolidating number bonds up to 10 and 20. Counting in steps of 1, 2, 3, 5 and 10, forwards and backwards. Recognising the place value of each digit in two-digit numbers (tens and ones). Ordering and representing numbers up to at least 100. Reading and writing numbers in numerals and words. Adding and subtracting numbers, including: a 2-digit number and ones, a 2-digit numb and tens, two 2-digit numbers, three 1-digit numbers. Recognising the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction. Solving problems involving place value, addition and subtraction Recognising and describing the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. 	 <u>Computing – Coding / Online Safety</u> To create a computer program using simple algorithms. To understand how to use the Timer and repeat command. To debug simple programs. To predict what the objects will do in other programs, based on their knowledge of what the object is capable of. To know how to refine searches using the Search tool. To know how to share work electronically using the display boards. To understand how we talk to others when they aren't there in front of us. To open and send simple online communications in the form of email.

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<u>RE</u>

- Answering the question: *Who is Muslim and how do they live?*
- Recognising the words of the Shahadah and that it is very important for Muslims.
- Identifying some of the key Muslim beliefs about God found in the Shahadah and the 99 names of Allah, and giving a simple description of what some of them mean.
- Giving examples of how stories about the Prophet show what Muslims believe about Muhammad.

Art Recognising and drawing

- lines of different sizes and thicknesses.
- Experimenting with dots, lines, zig-zags.
- Experimenting with thick and thin paintbrushes and the effect they can have.
- Learning about primary colours and how to mix colours to make new secondary colours and tints and tones.
- Looking at famous artists and using some of their techniques in their own work.

- Fundamentals of Movement:
- Finding space, running at speed and showing agility.
- Changing direction at speed.
- Throwing and catching accurately.
- Jumping, landing and balancing with control.
- REAL PE Floor Movement Patterns and dynamic and static balances.

Music

- CHARANGA UNIT Hands, Feet, Heart:
- Finding the pulse when listening to music.
- Clapping rhythms and knowing that rhythm is different to the pulse.
- Recognising and naming at least two instruments.
- Playing instruments accurately and in time.

PSHE – Me and My Relationships

- 'Growth Mindset' lesson exploring ways to help a child with a fixed mindset engage with their learning.
- Recognise that people have different ways of expressing their feelings.
- Understand the difference between bullying and unkind behaviour and understand that both are unacceptable ways of behaving.

- Identify some of the ways that good friends care for each other.
